

Capital City Scribes Workshop Scholarship Policies

1. Capital City Scribes will consider awarding one half-scholarship to each major workshop per 12 paying participants and one full scholarship to each mini-workshop per 10 paying participants.
2. The guild's intention is that these scholarships be awarded to members with financial need who would not otherwise be able to afford to attend a workshop. Therefore, members are asked to apply on that basis.
3. Only CCS members are eligible for a scholarship.
4. Those applying will be eligible for one scholarship per calendar year.
5. Members who have never attended a workshop will be given preference for mini-workshop scholarships.
6. Members who have never received a scholarship will be given preference.
7. With the exceptions noted in points 3 – 6, scholarships will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. If more applications are received than scholarships are available, the Workshop Committee will conduct a random drawing.
8. An application for a scholarship must be submitted with the required deposit for major workshop and following the not-before-date guidelines set by the Workshop Committee. Mini-workshop scholarship applications may be sent without a deposit.
